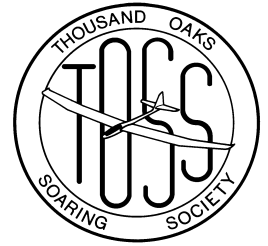


TOSSUP 03

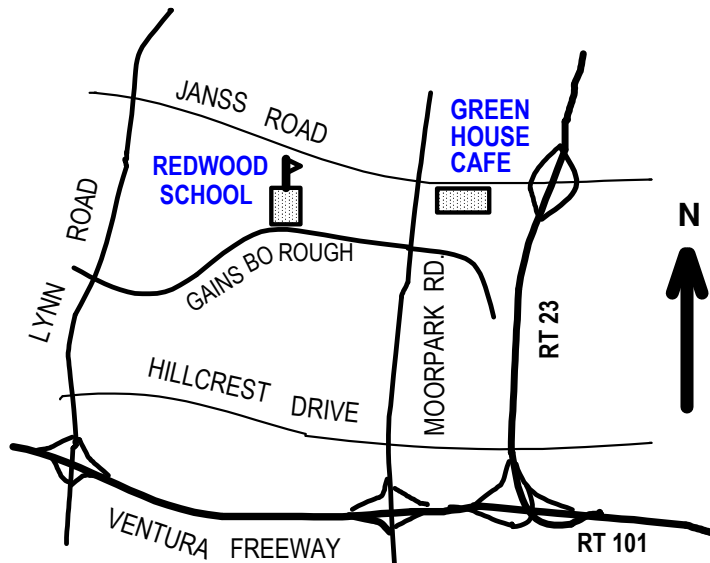

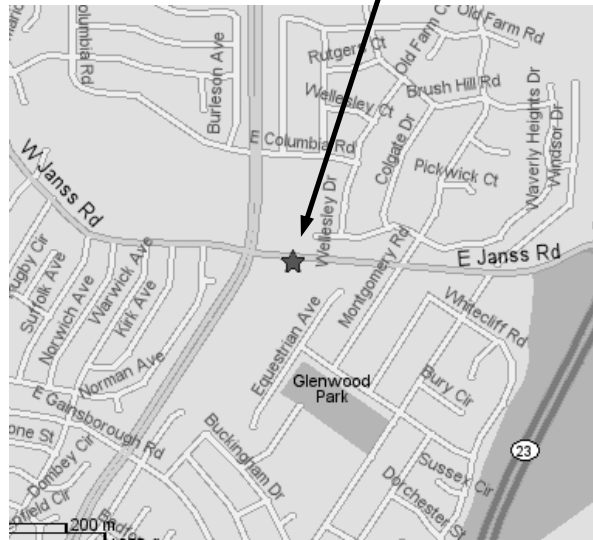
