Tasks were 3, 5, 8 & 4 minutes. The first two tasks landed in a 50' circle, scoring 10% of flight points for "in". The last two rounds were also landing in the circle but were scored using a normal landing tape centered in the circle (inside the circle scored the tape, outside zero).

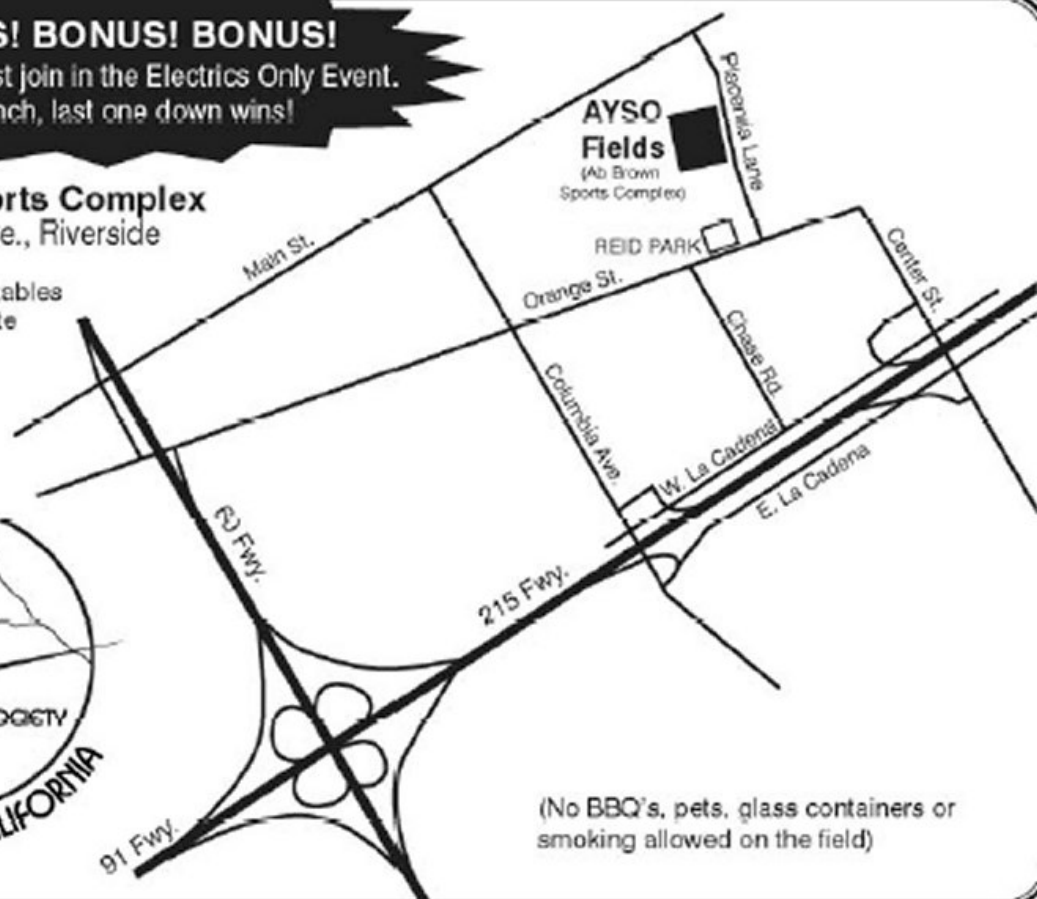

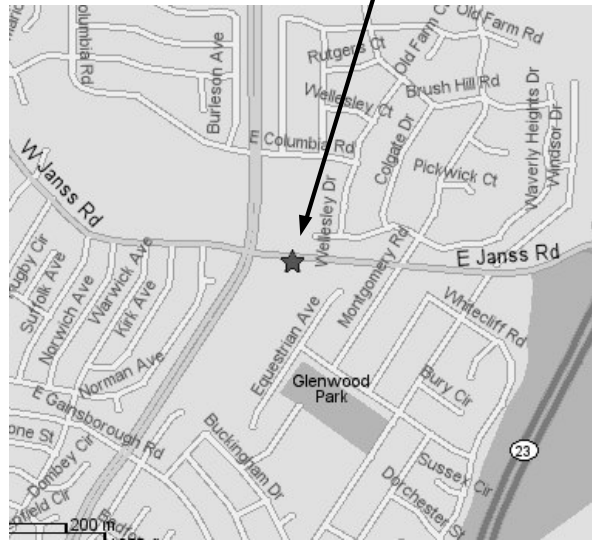
