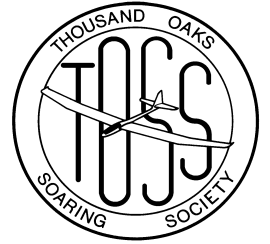


# TOSSUP 02

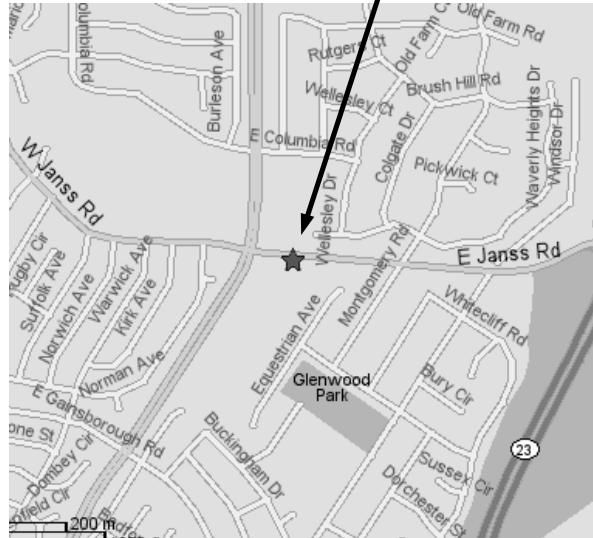
