### TOSS's Annual Party.....

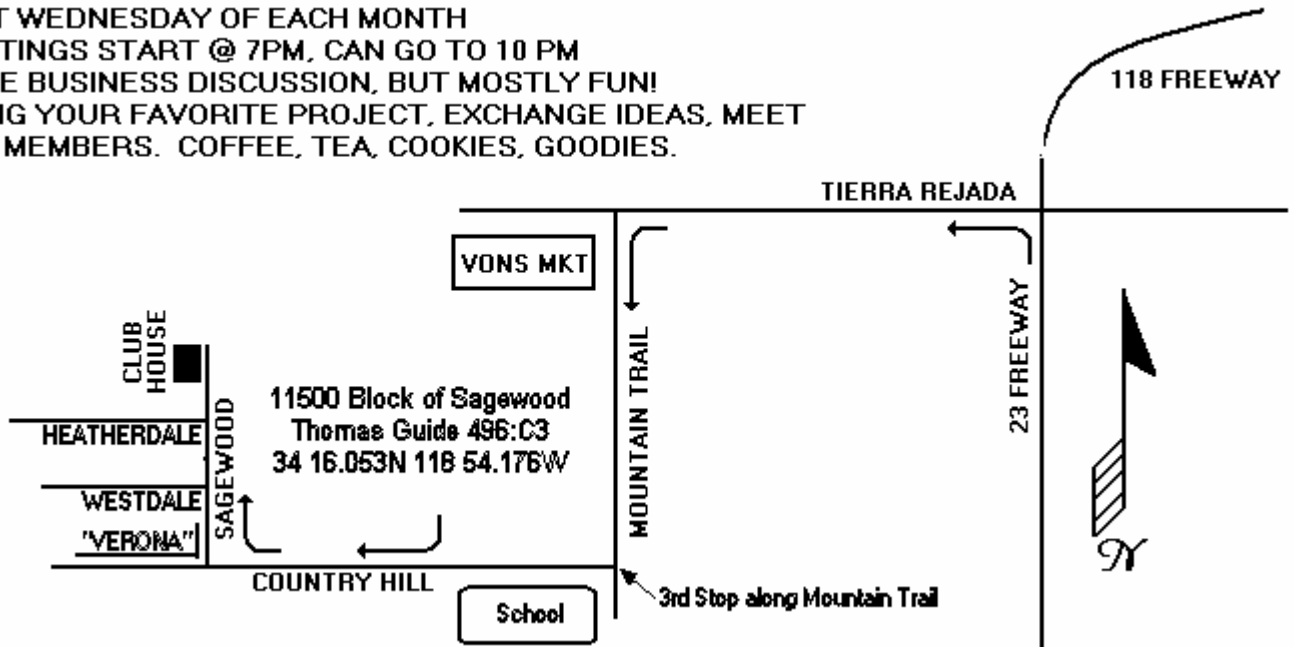
I've received a copy of an Email Gary sent to Bob about the plans for this year's club party.....here's an excerpt
